All serum titers > or = 1:2 should be considered evidence indicative of coccidioidomycosis, although titers of 1:2 and 1:4 should be confirmed by immunodiffusion testing. Titers exceeding 1:16 usually reflect disseminated disease. In general, higher titers are correlated with disease severity, and changes in serial titers are of prognostic value. A negative CF test does not, however, rule out the diagnosis. Only 70% of patients with cavitary disease are positive, and only 30% of patients with nodular disease are positive.

This test was developed and its analytical performance characteristics have been determined by Quest Diagnostics Infectious Disease. It has not been cleared or approved by FDA. This assay has been validated pursuant to the CLIA regulations and is used for clinical purposes.
