PROTEIN S, ACTIVITY Decreased levels of Protein S activity may be found in patients with hereditary deficiency, warfarin therapy, vitamin k deficiency, liver disease, DIC, or recent thrombosis as well as after surgery. In addition, it may be physiologic in pregnancy. An elevated Protein S activity is not clinically significant.
